‘On the road to recovery’

13 Mercy Home employees have recovered from COVID-19;
resident numbers also expected to improve

EAGLE LAKE, Maine (Jan. 12, 2021) – Mercy Home Administrator Denise Raymond stated in her most recent COVID-19 Pandemic Update to her employees and affiliated staff that nine residents of the nursing facility are “on the road to recovery” and 13 employees have recovered. She hopes to soon receive formal confirmation of the nine suspected resident recoveries.

The last swabbing clinic to test for the novel coronavirus at Mercy Home was on Friday, Jan. 8. Swabs from 58 employees and affiliated staff and swabs from 10 residents were sent to lab; results are pending. The next clinic is scheduled for tomorrow, Jan. 13. Raymond is trying to schedule the clinics closer to a five-day cycle.

“Stay safe and healthy,” Raymond encouraged her team.
